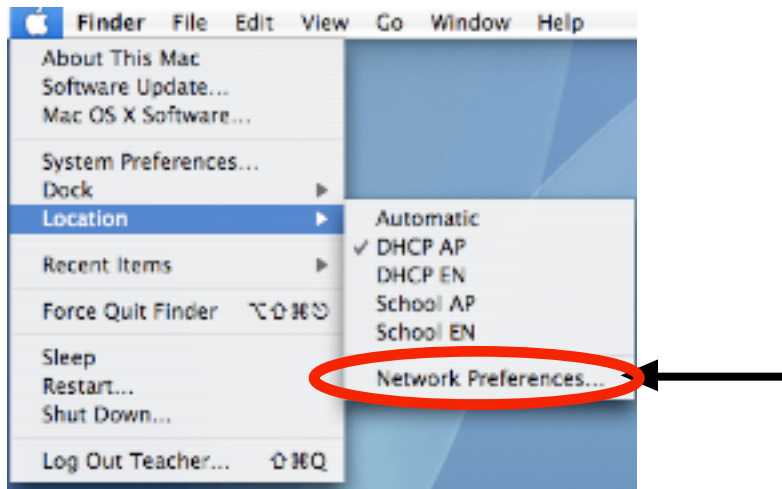


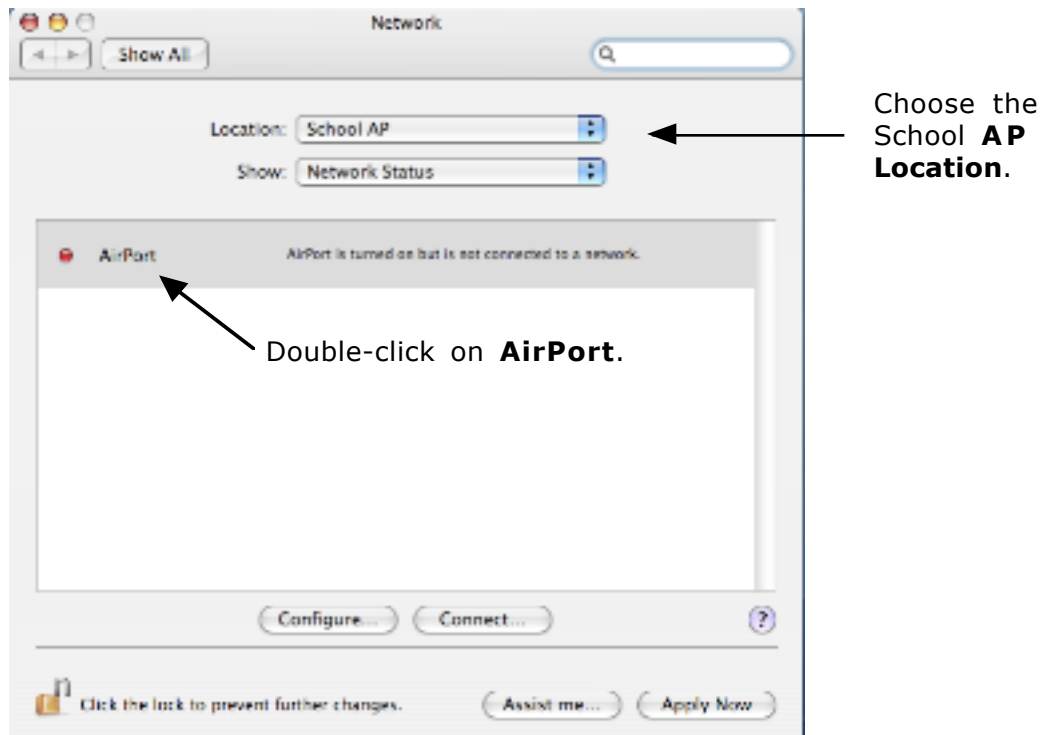
Changing DNS Numbers

If you are having a problem connecting to the Internet with a School location, incorrect DNS numbers may be the cause. Follow these instructions to change the DNS numbers in your **School AP** and **School EN** locations.

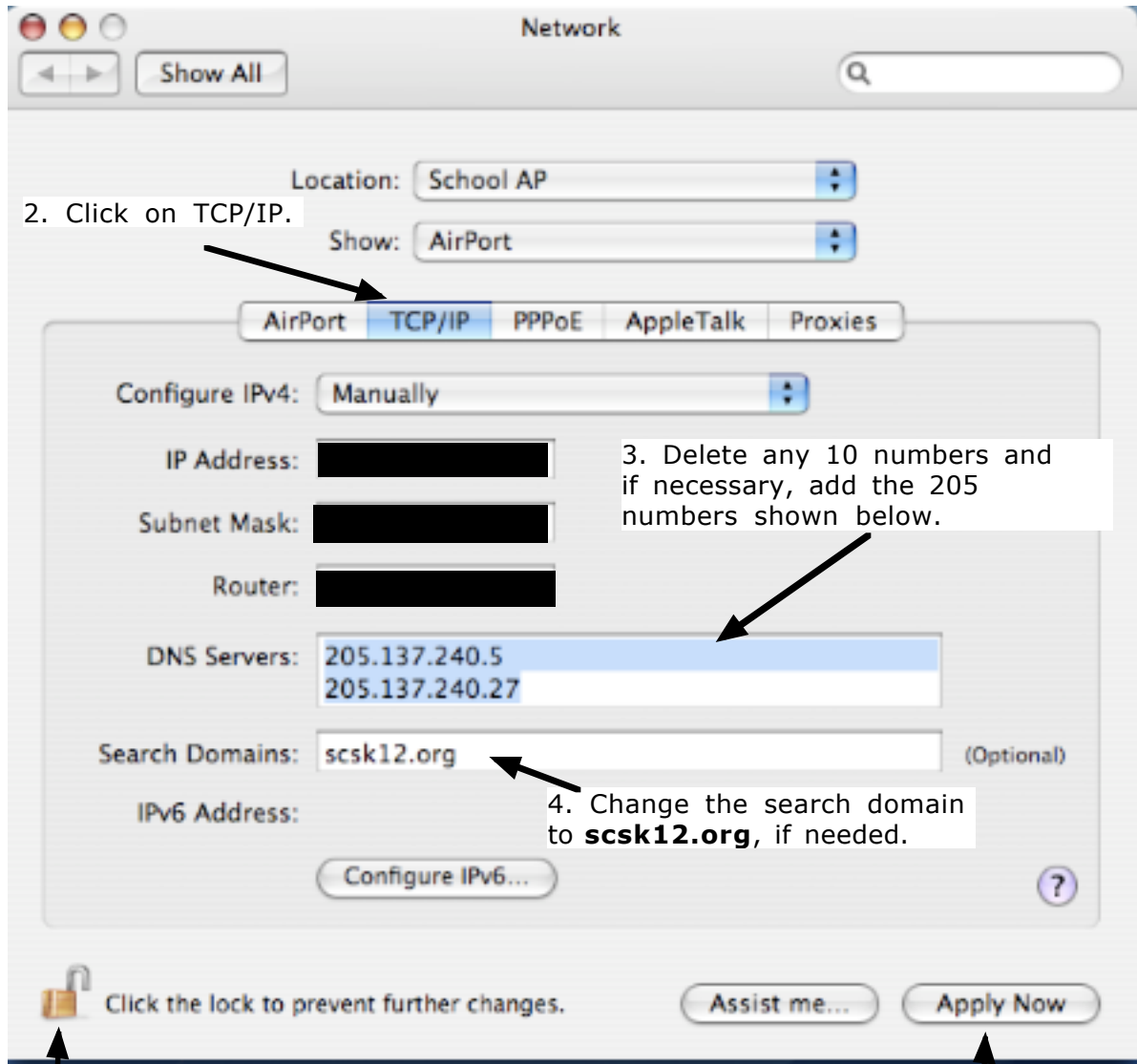
1. From the Apple menu, choose Location>Network Preferences.



2. Change the **School AP** DNS numbers.



3. Delete all DNS number that start with 10 and add the following numbers:
205.137.240.5 and **205.137.240.27**
NOTE: DO NOT change the IP Address, Subnet Mask, or Router Fields.



2. Click on TCP/IP.

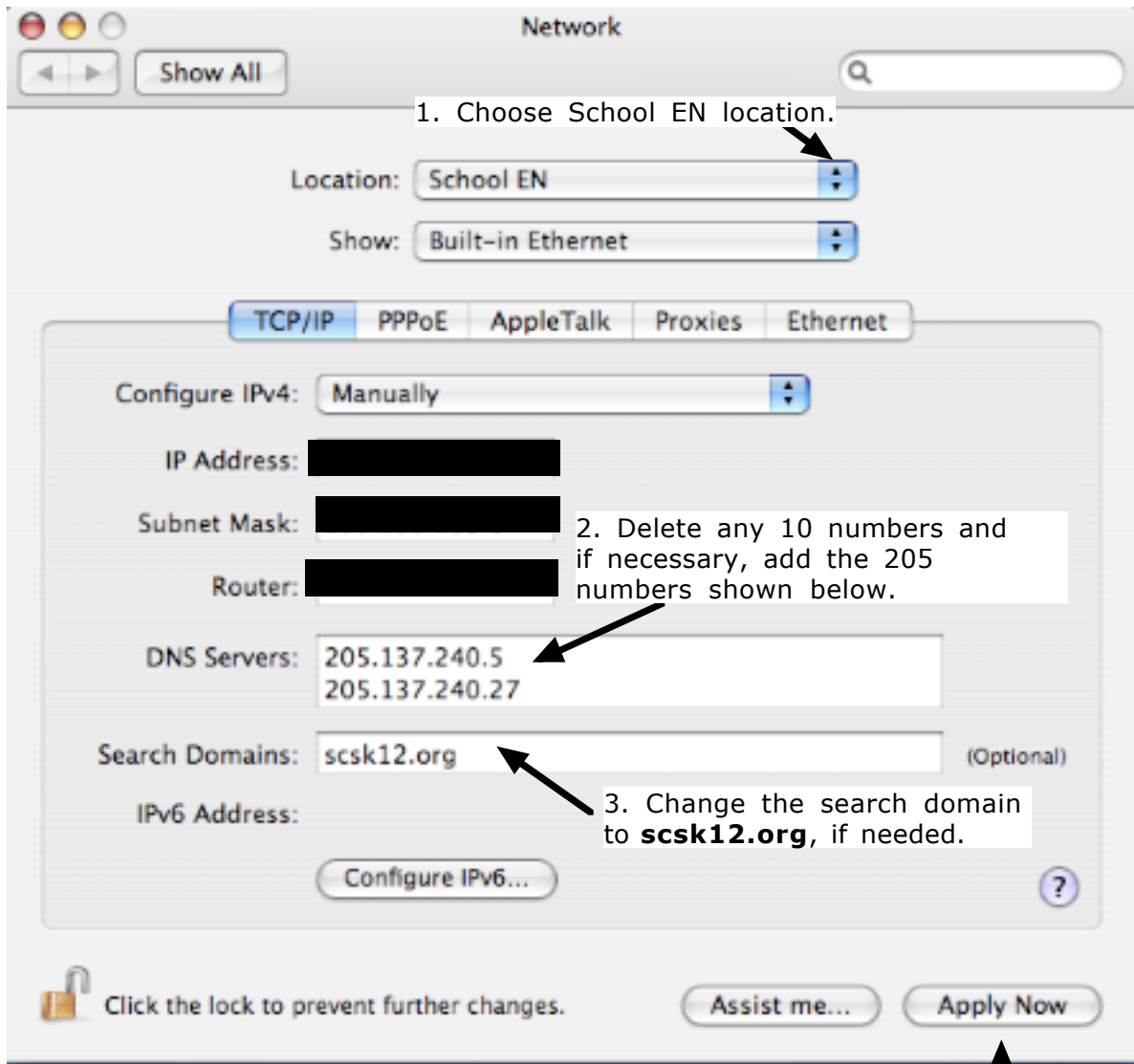
3. Delete any 10 numbers and if necessary, add the 205 numbers shown below.

4. Change the search domain to **scsk12.org**, if needed.

1. Click to unlock if necessary. The password is the same as the password to login to the computer.

4. Click **Apply Now**.

4. Choose the School EN location from the Location: drop-down menu.
NOTE: DO NOT change the IP Address, Subnet Mask, or Router Fields.
